Dear Provider,

As part of implementing the CCDF reauthorization changes, the DWS Office of Child Care (OCC) is required to set subsidy payment rates "with base payment rates established at least at a level sufficient for child care providers to meet health, safety, quality, and staffing requirements." 45 CFR Section 98.45 (2016)).



OCC has presented previous drafts of the Child Care Quality System (CCQS) and has made further changes based on feedback received. As part of the ongoing conversation on CCQS, OCC will discuss the feedback and most recent proposal of the quality system at a public meeting in November.
