The High-Quality School Readiness (HQSR) grant will be reopening within the next few days!



The Utah Legislature recently made changes to the Utah School Readiness Initiative. The Utah School Readiness Initiative Amendments (HB0380S2) requires that a revised grant application be released. If you are interested in applying or re-submitting your application, be sure to read through the entire application because of the changes required by the new legislation.

This initiative provides resources to eligible child care providers offering preschool programming to economically disadvantaged three-and four-year-old children. Funding is targeted at child care providers seeking outside coaching and other program needs as part of efforts to improve preschool and school readiness outcomes.
