Introducing Care About Childcare **Emergency Alert System**



Child Care Programs, After School Programs, Preschools and Family, Friend and Neighbor (FFN) programs that have a profile in the CAC Referral Database will now receive an e-mail and text alert if there is an emergency in their area. These e-mails and texts will come directly from your local emergency responders.

The email will say it is from the Utah Office of Child Care and the text from number 435-261-9600. You may also be contacted by phone, e-mail or text if emergency responders are doing a drill that involves the emergency alert system in your area, such as the Great Utah Shakeout.

Emergency texts and emails will go to the cell number or email address you have in your CAC Referral Database Profile and all caregivers cell numbers attached to your program in the Registry.

Please contact your local Care About Childcare Office to check and update your contact information or if you would like to receive training or information about emergency and disaster preparedness.
